- How to provide ongoing support as participants complete the honour.

- 1 With the help & approval of your leader/s:
 - a. Plan your journey to become a World Changer for Jesus
 - b. Find a prayer partner to share your journey. *Refer to World Changers Bible Insert (WCBI part v).*
- 2 In a few words explain:
 - a. What it means to be a World Changer for Jesus. *Refer to WCBI part i.*
 - b. How Jesus can help you become a World Changer. *Hint: Refer to Philippians 4:13.*
- 3 Select five (5) friends you will pray for daily. (*WCBI part ii*)
- 4 Read John Chapter 17 and document your personal devotional life by keeping a journal, outlining your prayer life, for at least 5 days. (*WCBI part iii*)
- 5 Demonstrate some ways a World Changer can start a conversation about Jesus. Include the following approaches: indirect starter, direct starter and the ‘Word Stack’ (*WCBI part vi*). *Hint: Use creativity to dramatize the different approaches.*
- 6 Explain three things you must genuinely do when leading people to Jesus (*WCBI part vii*)
 - a. You must be credible
 - b. You must be relational
 - c. You must be intentional
- 7 Demonstrate the steps on how to conduct a Bible reading or study (*WCBI part viii*):
 - a. Before the Bible reading
 - b. During the Bible reading
 - c. After the Bible reading
- 8 In a few paragraphs outline, either your own testimony, or the testimony of someone you respect. Adapt the three stages based on the testimony of Paul the Apostle: *Hints: Read Paul’s story in Acts: 26:4-23. Also WCBI part ix.*
 - a. Before you met Jesus
 - b. Meeting Jesus (ie conversion)
 - c. After you meet Jesus
- 9 Choose one of the ‘Easy Ways to Share the Gospel’ (*WCBI parts x-xii*) and demonstrate by sharing the story with another person.

- 10 In a group of at least three (3) people, begin reading some of your favourite stories in the Bible. *Hints: i) the book of Mark is a good place to start. ii) Invite one of your five friends if you're comfortable. You can also use the World Changer Book Mark Bible study guides, as they are a great way to introduce your friends to the core truths of scripture.*
- 11 Don't forget to continue to pray for the guidance of the Holy Spirit as you introduce others to Jesus, our personal friend and saviour. Don't cease to provide support and encouragement to those whom you've played a part in changing their world.
