We've developed this form to help enrich your Christian Worship experience. You can use it:

- *To analyse worship experiences led by others and to reflect and learn from what they do, or;*
- *To help you prepare and record your own worship experiences and make a personal assessment, or;*
- *To allow a friend or teacher/trainer to give feedback on your role as a Christian Worship leader.*

It is essential that those fulfilling the following roles will dedicate themselves to serving our God.

- *Worship leaders – Those who 'lead out' in the service (make announcements, public prayer etc)*
- *Musicians – Those who play musical instruments*
- *Singers – Those who lead out with the singing*
- *Item people – Those who make special presentations (music, scripture reading etc)*
- *Providers – Those who do behind-the-scenes work (public address, seating, collect offering etc)*
- *Speaker – The person who presents the main message or leads the study of God's Word.*

Key Elements of a Worship Service	Comments
Call to worship: rousing music, welcome etc	
Establish a spirit of Worship: music, singing prayer, offering etc	
Set the 'scene' for the presentation of the message or study: music, singing, children's story, prayer, scripture readings, special 'item' etc	
Present God's message / Study His Word	
Reflect on the message and its application: testimony, dedication, commitment, quiet personal reflection and prayer, etc	
End the Service: concluding remarks, music, singing, prayer.	



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Worship Service Checklist	Comments
Details of the Worship Service program are communicated to all involved	
The venue is ready, well before starting time	
Layout is arranged so that those leading out can be seen clearly by the worshippers	
All 'equipment' is in place. (pulpit, offering bags)	
Public address system is checked and microphones etc are allocated	
Electronic communication systems are ready and operate as intended: Ie PowerPoint	
Music instruments are all tuned and ready to go	
Everyone with a 'leading out' role: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Is aware of the theme of the service. • Is aware of their role (when and what) • Is prepared and ready to do their part • Recognises that they are 'in God's service' 	
Building lighting is operating as intended	
Worshippers have access to the Scriptures and music words etc	
Distractions are removed or minimised.
