Snapshot of Honour

The First Aid 3 Honour is the most advanced honour in First Aid that is awarded by the South Pacific Division.

This honour gives recognition of a high degree of competency in First Aid.

Many countries (ie Australia) have strict legislation in relation to First Aid training; what must be taught and who is registered to train. It is most important that local legal requirements are checked first.

Requirements

IMPORTANT INFORMATION. Please read before commencing this honour

There is a world-wide trend for only accredited persons or organisations to train people in government-approved First Aid courses. Often there are serious legal consequences if these requirements are not met.

Because of the diversity of countries (and local legal requirements) in the South Pacific Division, we have included the General Conference Requirements overleaf for reference only.

For Australia

The National Training Information Service (NTIS) is the official national register of information on training packages, qualifications, courses, units of competency and Registered Training Organisations (RTOs). In relation to First Aid, NTIS approves and lists First Aid training courses. First Aid trainers must also be approved and registered by NTIS.

It is a legal requirement that only Registered Training Organisations be used for training First Aid. Most conferences have a list of First Aid RTOs in their Conference.
