#Skill Level:	Level 3
<u>Pre-requisites:</u>	Puppetry 1 Honour; Christian Storytelling 1 Honour
Preparation Time:	Substantial (more than 8 hrs)
Physical Requirements:	Minimal, but some physical endurance required to do a 'show'
Equipment/Materials Required:	Puppetry materials.
Location:	Indoors primarily, but can also be adapted for outdoors.
Sabbath Appropriate:	Can be adapted.
<u>Safety & Legal Requirements:</u>	Refer to and comply with Local, State and Country Requirements. All duty of care must be complied with.

Note: The requirements listed at the above General Conference (GC) website were assessed carefully. They have been adjusted to meet the needs of South Pacific Division.

1. Have the Puppetry 1 Honour and Christian Storytelling 1 Honour.
2. Complete one of the following training roles:
 - a. Participate in the training of others in the Puppetry 1 Honour; or,
 - b. Using your personal experience and knowledge, develop a useful set of notes which illustrate the art of Puppetry and may be used to train others.
3. Make at least two additional puppets (different type from previous)
One puppet is to have a rod attached for arm manipulation.
4. Develop characters and voices for these puppets.
5. Write a six to eight minute script involving any of your puppets.
6. Construct your own staging.
7.
 - a. Give at least five successful public performances. One performance must include your script written for Requirement 5;
and,
 - b. Obtain an assessment of each of the five performances (by someone not related) using the Puppetry Performance Evaluation Checklist, showing continued improvement in the art of puppetry.
