MEANING OF THE PATHFINDER EMBLEM:

- 1. Red (sacrifice)
- a. Reminds us of Christ. "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life." John 3:16.
- b. "... Offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God ..." Romans 12:1.
- 2. Three sides

Completeness of the Godhead - Father, Son, Holy Ghost.

- 3. Gold (Excellence)
- a. "I counsel you to buy from me gold refined in the fire, so you can become rich." Revelation 3:18.
- b. Standard of measurement. The Pathfinder club has high standards to help build strong character for the kingdom of heaven.
- 4. Shield (Protection)
- a. In the Scripture, God is often called the shield of His people. "Do not be afraid . . . I am your shield." Genesis 15:1.
- b. "... take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one." Ephesians 6:16.
- 5. White (Purity)
- a. "He who overcomes will, like them, be dressed in white." Revelation 3:5.
- b. We desire to have the purity and righteousness of Christ's life in our lives.
- 6. Pathfinders

7. Blue (Loyalty)
